

MINUTES
Public Hearing
Water System Plan Update
April 10, 2012
6:30 pm

Mayor Heinzman calls the public hearing meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Roll Call: Mayor Heinzman, Mike Swanson, Eddie Hills, Rita Burke and Gail Ganga were present. Mike Couch was absent.

Others in attendance were Stacey Clear and Mike Jauhola from Gray & Osborne, Mark Kitchen, Cas Hancock, and Debbie Boyd, town of Lyman employees, Sean Ganga, Andy Hawkings, and Arne Svendson.

This is continuation of the Public Hearing held on March 13, 2012.

Mike Jauhola introduces Stacey Clear and states Doug Jacobson has left Gray & Osborne and Stacey will be replacing him in assisting the town of Lyman with the CDGB Planning only Grant application.

Rita Burke a councilmember that missed the last public hearing asked Mike to explain to her the work they are doing. He tells her the update of the water system plan will benefit the entire community. The towns existing plan was completed in 2002. The state regulations governing water purveyors require them to update their water-system plans every six years. The town of Lyman is several years behind in this update and has a deadline of August 2012 to have a draft of the plan to DOH.

The updated plan will help in the future as it looks at projected growth in Lyman.

The new plan will help Lyman better calculate a buy in charge for new users, and will help identify the capital improvements needed to accommodate that new growth.

The Water System Comprehensive Plan needs to be in place to qualify for grants and loans in the future also.
