

ORDINANCE # 249
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
Ordinance #181 of the Town of Lyman
Adding Cable TV and implementing the tax.

WHEREAS, The State of Washington does give towns the power to license for revenue and Levy a tax on public utilities; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Lyman adopted Ordinance #181 Establishing a Public Utility Tax on May 14, 2002; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of Lyman is desirous of amending Ordinance #181, to add revenue to the Street fund;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained, that the council of the Town of Lyman, Washington:
Does add Cable TV, the definitions thereof and implement the tax of 6% upon cable services.


Section 1. Definitions

“Cable Services” means the one-way transmission to Subscribers of video programming or other programming service, and Subscriber interaction, if any, which is required for the selection or use by the Subscriber of such video programming.


“Basic Cable Service” means all signals of local television broadcast stations provided to any Subscriber (except a signal secondarily transmitted by satellite carrier beyond the local service area of such station, regardless of how such signal is ultimately received by the Cable Television System) any public, educational, and governmental programming required by the Franchise to be carried on the basic tier, and any additional video programming signals and service added to the basic tier by a cable Franchisee.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective after its passage by the Council, approval and publication as required by law.
