

**LYMAN TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
September 12, 2017**

Mayor Hills called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

Roll Call: Mayor Hills, Mike S, Jeremy M, Mark H, Mike C. were present, Gail G was absent.

Minutes, A motion was made and 2nd to accept the minutes from the August meeting. Motion passed with a.i.f.

Treasurers report: A motion was made and 2nd to accept the Treasurers report. Motion passed with a.i.f.

Unpaid bills, A motion was made and 2nd to pay the bills for September. Motion passed with a.i.f.
