

MINUTES  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
Zoom Meeting  
March 9, 2021

Mayor Hills called the meeting to order at 7:00

**ROLL CALL:** Mayor Hills, Mike Swanson, Jeremy Mast, Ron Hodgin, Mike Couch and Charlene Bray were present.

**Minutes:** Mike S. made a motion to accept the minutes for the February meeting. Jeremy M. 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion passed with a.i.f.

**Treasurers Report:** Mike S made a motion to accept the Treasurers Report for February. The motion was 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion passed with a.i.f.

**Unpaid Bills:** Mike C. made a motion to pay the bills for March. Ron H 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Discussion: Jeremy asked about Turner Fabrication. The bumper was fixed, and tie downs welded on the bed of the 1 ton. Mayor Hills asked about the Verizon bill. The Public Works phone has used 1200 minutes last month which is 800 more than the 400 allotted. The friends and family option will be updated to reflect his usage to keep costs down. Motion passed with a.i.f.

**Correspondence:** Tammie from Heart-to-Heart Charity wrote to council and asked if they would allow an Easter Egg Hunt at the Town Hall or Park. Mayor Hills commented the park would be a good place and that the bathrooms could be opened for the day. The only stipulation was that the cars were not parked in the grass that was planted last year. No parking signs will be put up around the park.

**Unfinished Business:** Leila Willoughby from the Water Shed Company was present to give the council an update on the progress of the SMP. A Public Hearing is scheduled for April 20<sup>th</sup>. Council will receive a copy of Skagit County's plan prior to the meeting.

**New Business:** The owners of the Lyman Tavern have been doing repairs and have brought attention to the gutter on the north side of the old town hall that needs repair and the north side of the building needs paint. Mayor Hills talked with Caleb about a possible leak in the same area so he will have him talk with the tavern owner and e
